Keywords: word; another word; lower case except names. *Minimum 3 keywords*

Font size must be 11 of Times New Roman

Paragraph: use this for the first paragraph in a section, or to continue after an extract.

New paragraph: use this style when you need to begin a new paragraph.

Check Pointers

- Please count **in text citations** of all tables and figures in ascending order.
- References citation must be in **ascending** order in the article
- In case of any scheme or annexure, please provide **in-text citation** in chronological order with relevant legends and details.
- Use photograph of any patient with their prior approval and share the **patient consent form** during the manuscript submission hiding the patient's unnecessary identity/information.
- All **tables** must be in MS word/excel formats
- All **Figures** must be in below image formats of high quality with standard resolution (250 to 300 dpi). Common image formats are:
 - TIFF (.tif file extension, Tag Image File Format)
 - JPEG (.jpg file extension, Joint Photographic Experts Group)
 - PNG (.png file extension, Portable Network Graphic)
 - EPS (.eps file extension, Encapsulated Post-script; used mostly for illustrations and vector-based files)
- The references within main manuscript file are to be include as superscript without any brackets. For example.
